#### **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling \$49.3 million in Vermont, supporting 764 jobs and \$108.6 million in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Vermont supported 2,552 jobs and 229 businesses.

#### Impact of Cancer in Vermont<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 3,840 will reside in Vermont.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 1,450 residents of Vermont.
