## **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling \$377 million in Virginia, supporting 5,765 jobs and \$1.095 billion in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Virginia supported **24,681** jobs and **1,428** businesses.

### Impact of Cancer in Virginia<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 42,420 will reside in Virginia.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 15,260 residents of Virginia.
