# **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$12 million in Wyoming, supporting 245 jobs and \$49 million in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in Wyoming supported 1,345 jobs and 284 businesses.

### Impact of Cancer in Wyoming<sup>3</sup>

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 3,580 will reside in Wyoming.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 1,240 residents of Wyoming.

# A Strong National Priority<sup>4</sup>



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
