Economic Impact of Research²

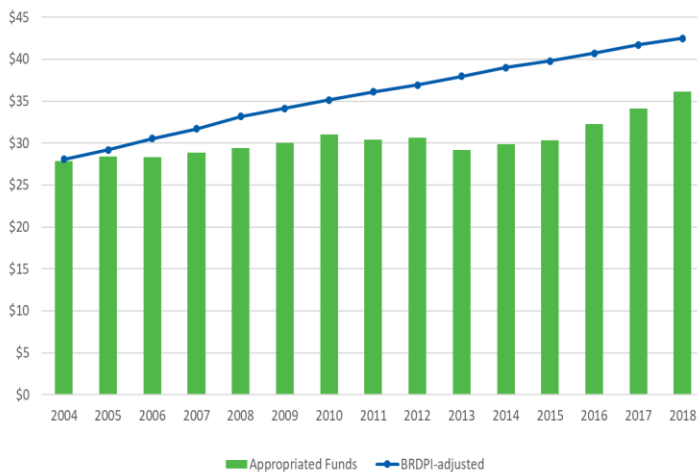
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$298.2 million** in Alabama, supporting **4,661 jobs** and **\$715.4 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Alabama supported **11,143 jobs** and **634 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Alabama³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **27,830** will reside in Alabama.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,720** residents of Alabama.
