Economic Impact of Research²

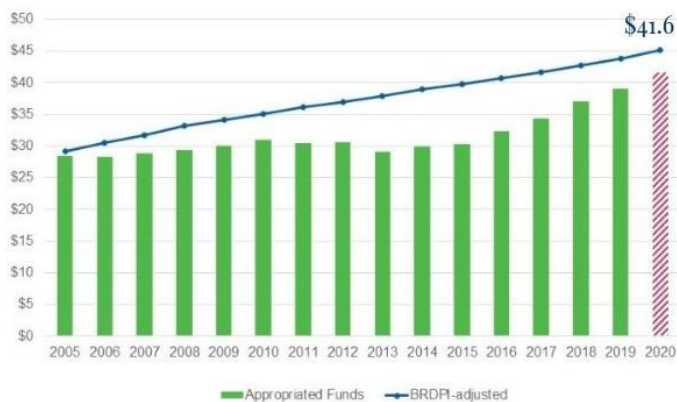
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$350.7 million** in Alabama, supporting **5,384** jobs and **\$826 million** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Alabama supported **13,100** jobs and **1,014** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Alabama³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **28,950** will reside in Alabama.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,630** residents of Alabama.
