Economic Impact of Research²

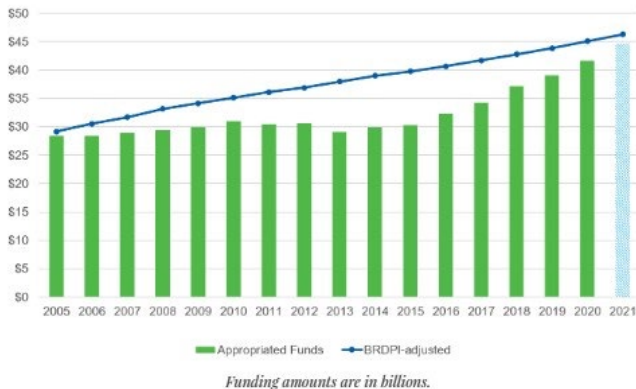
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$391.6 million** in Alabama, supporting **5,996 jobs** and **\$920 million** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Alabama supported **13,100 jobs** and **1,014 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Alabama³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **28,570** will reside in Alabama.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,530** residents of Alabama.
