Economic Impact of Research²

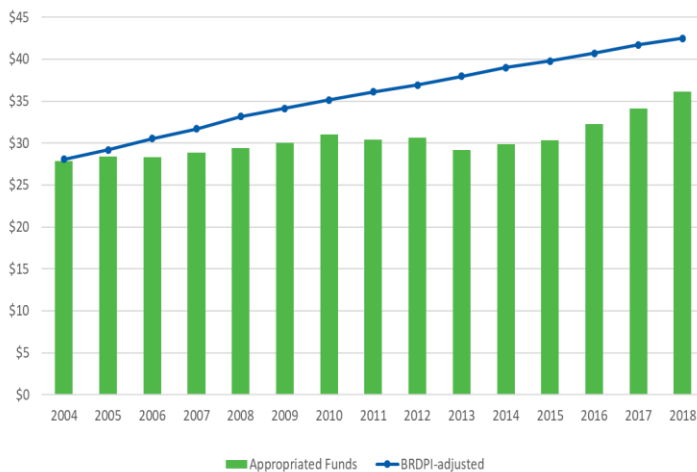
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$189 million** in Arizona, supporting **4,080 jobs** and **\$601.2 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Arizona supported **22,953 jobs** and **1,250 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Arizona³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **34,740** will reside in Arizona.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **12,390** residents of Arizona.
