Economic Impact of Research²

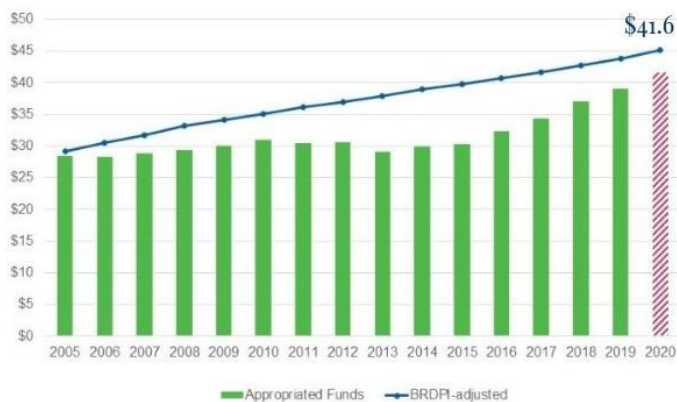
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$4.243 billion** in California, supporting **66,937** jobs and **\$11.895 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in California supported **267,844** jobs and **9,924** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in California³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **186,920** will reside in California.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **60,590** residents of California.
