#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

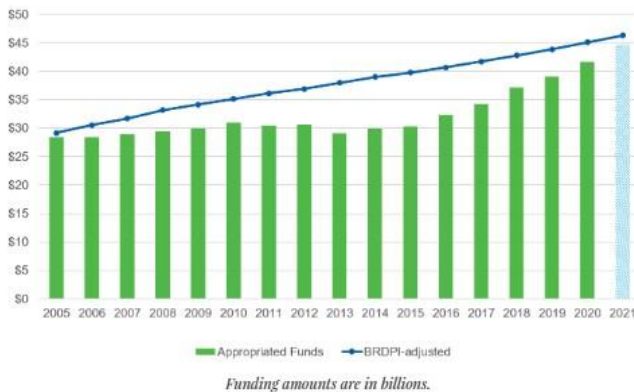
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$4.591 billion** in California, supporting **72,594 jobs** and **\$12.9 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in California supported **267,844 jobs** and **9,924 businesses**.

#### Impact of Cancer in California<sup>3</sup>

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **172,040** will reside in California.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **60,660** residents of California.
