Economic Impact of Research²

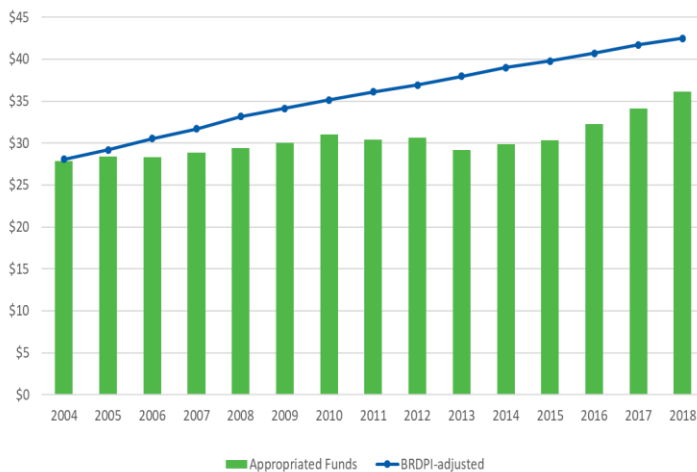
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$805.5 million** in Illinois, supporting **14,322 jobs** and **\$2.463 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Illinois supported **70,412 jobs** and **3,396 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Illinois³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **66,330** will reside in Illinois.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **24,670** residents of Illinois.
