United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$895.4** million in Illinois, supporting **15,768** jobs and **\$2.713** billion in economic activity.

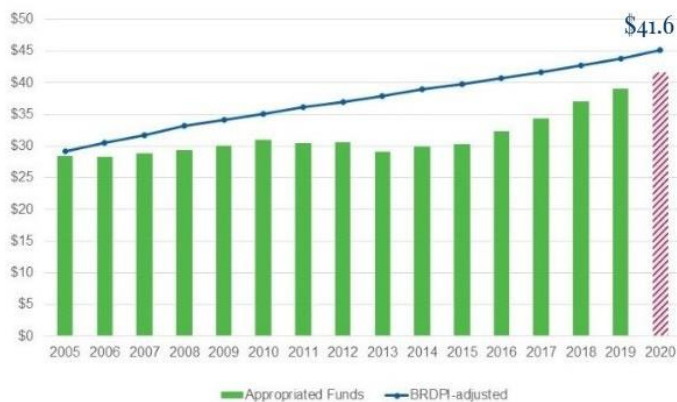
In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Illinois supported **85,210** jobs and **3,778** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Illinois³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **68,560** will reside in Illinois.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **24,410** residents of Illinois.
