Economic Impact of Research²

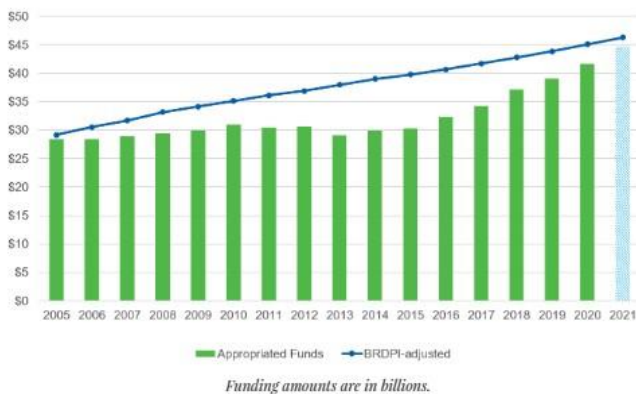
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.012 billion** in Illinois, supporting **17,736** jobs and **\$3.051 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Illinois supported **85,210** jobs and **3,778** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Illinois³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **71,990** will reside in Illinois.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **24,220** residents of Illinois.
