Economic Impact of Research²

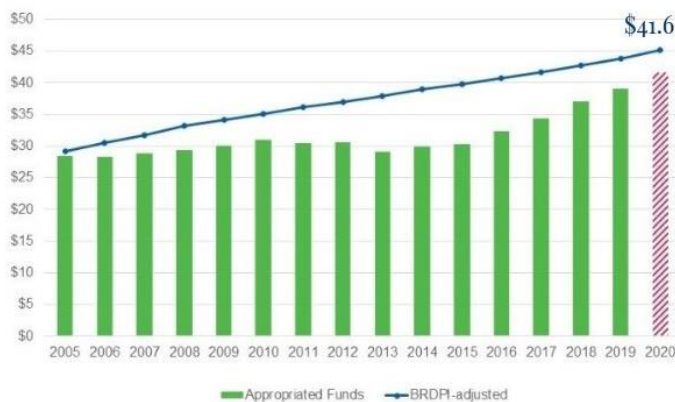
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$276.8 million** in Indiana, supporting **4,981** jobs and **\$774 million** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Indiana supported **58,018** jobs and **1,730** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Indiana³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **35,280** will reside in Indiana.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **13,690** residents of Indiana.
