### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

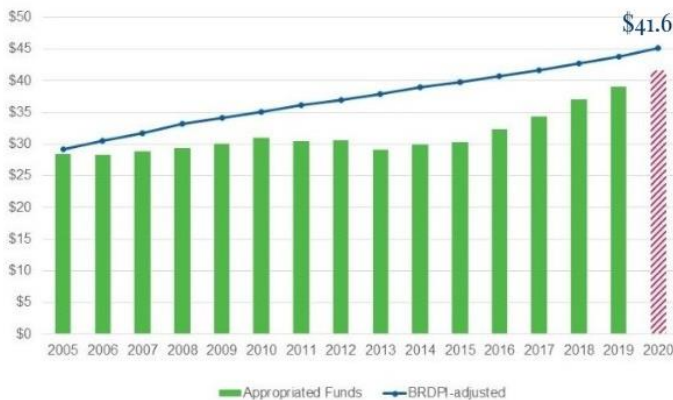
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$191.9 million** in Iowa, supporting **3,100 jobs** and **\$452 million** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Iowa supported **24,540 jobs** and **1,282 businesses**.

#### Impact of Cancer in Iowa<sup>3</sup>

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **17,810** will reside in Iowa.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **6,480** residents of Iowa.

#### Holden Comprehensive Cancer Center, University of Iowa

University of Iowa **Holden Comprehensive Cancer Center** is Iowa's only NCI-Designated Comprehensive Cancer Center. Nearly 1,200 staff and cancer center members, including faculty from 41 academic departments, collaborate to drive Holden's research, education, and patient-care missions. At any given time, Holden participates in more than 300 active clinical trials. Holden is the recipient of two NCI Specialized Program of Research Excellence (SPORE) grants, including the first and only neuroendocrine tumor SPORE.
