Economic Impact of Research²

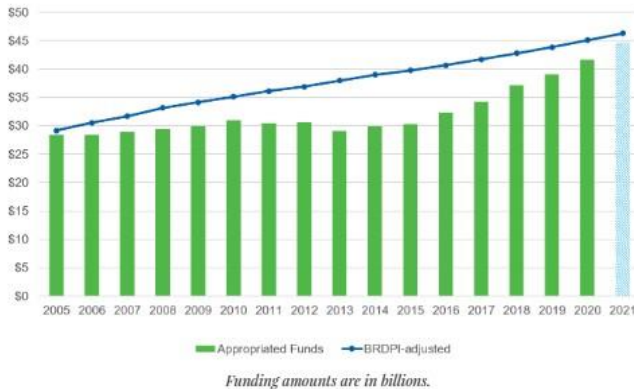
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$202 million** in Iowa, supporting **3,298** jobs and **\$481 million** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Iowa supported **24,540** jobs and **1,282** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Iowa³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **18,460** will reside in Iowa.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **6,440** residents of Iowa.

Holden Comprehensive Cancer Center, University of Iowa

University of Iowa **Holden Comprehensive Cancer Center** is an NCI-Designated Comprehensive Cancer Center. Over 1,000 staff and cancer center members, including faculty from more than 40 academic departments, collaborate to drive Holden's research, education, and patient care missions. At any given time, Holden participates in more than 300 active clinical trials. Holden is also the recipient of two NCI Specialized Program of Research Excellence (SPORE) grants, including the first and only neuroendocrine tumor SPORE.
