Economic Impact of Research²

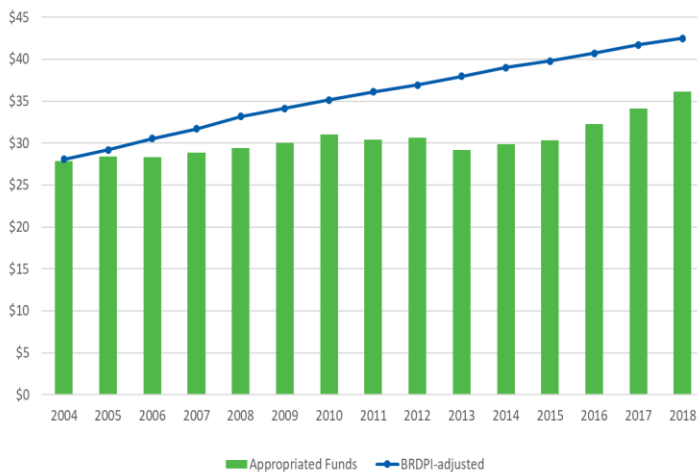
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$188 million** in Kentucky, supporting **3,229 jobs** and **\$482.9 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Kentucky supported **10,924 jobs** and **950 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Kentucky³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **25,990** will reside in Kentucky.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,590** residents of Kentucky.
