#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

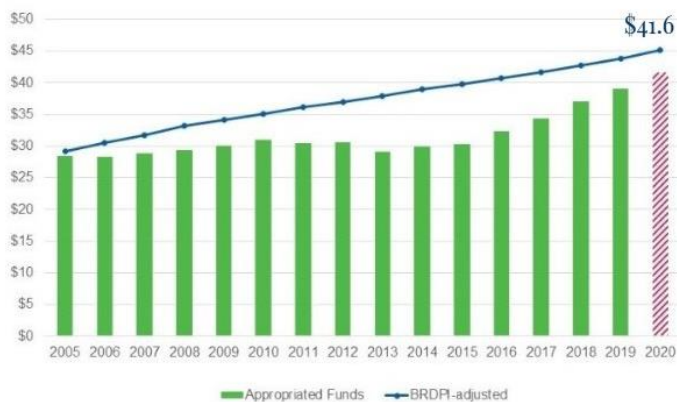
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **207.6 million** in Kentucky, supporting **3,518 jobs** and **\$526 million** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Kentucky supported **14,030 jobs** and **1,212 businesses**.

#### Impact of Cancer in Kentucky<sup>3</sup>

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **26,400** will reside in Kentucky.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,580** residents of Kentucky.
