Economic Impact of Research²

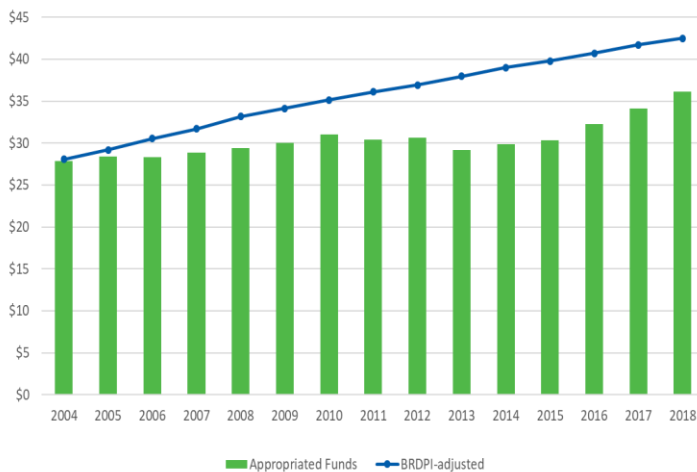
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.611 billion** in Maryland, supporting **20,836** jobs and **\$3.742 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Maryland supported **33,767** jobs and **1,950** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Maryland³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **33,810** will reside in Maryland.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,780** residents of Maryland.
