Economic Impact of Research²

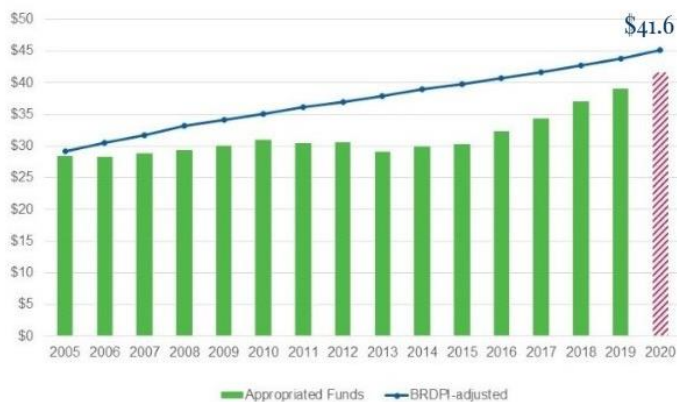
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.531 billion** in Maryland, supporting **19,941** jobs and **\$3.582 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Maryland supported **36,194** jobs and **2,281** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Maryland³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **33,140** will reside in Maryland.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,780** residents of Maryland.
