IMPACT

Economic Impact of Research²

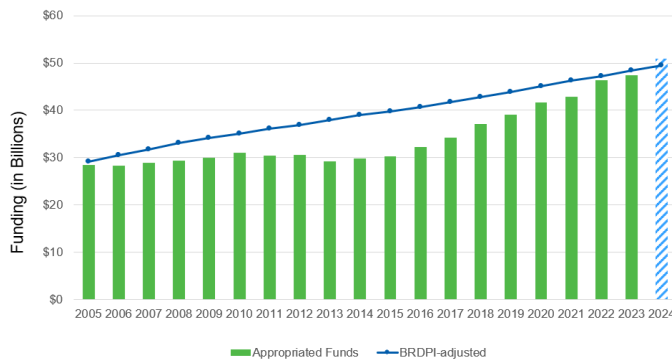
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2022, NIH funded awards totaling **\$3.281 billion** in Massachusetts, supporting **39,957 jobs** and **\$7.74 billion** in economic activity.
- In FY 2022, the biopharmaceutical industry in Massachusetts supported **131,659 jobs** and **4,601 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Massachusetts³

- In 2023, an estimated 1,958,310 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **42,880** will reside in Massachusetts.
- In 2023, an estimated 609,820 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **12,420** residents of Massachusetts.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



Funding for NIH has increased by \$17 billion, or nearly 58 percent, from FY 2015 to FY 2023. Due to this strong support, NIH is able to support more groundbreaking science – but we can't afford to stop now.

We are advocating for \$50.924 billion in FY 2024 appropriations for the NIH.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
