Economic Impact of Research²

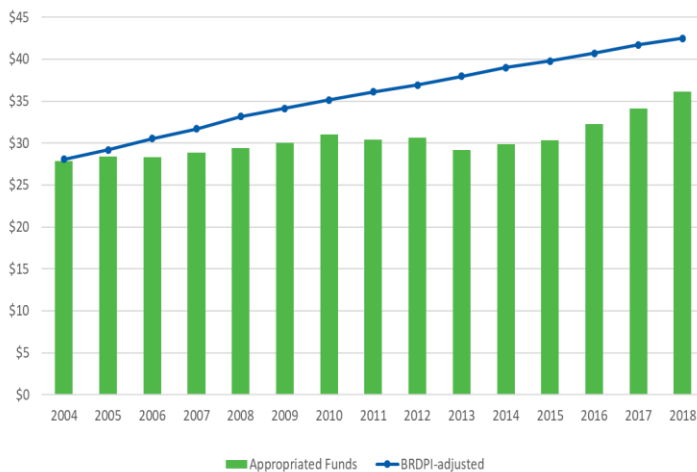
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$707.7 million** in Michigan, supporting **11,442 jobs** and **\$1.835 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Michigan supported **40,929 jobs** and **1,731 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Michigan³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **56,590** will reside in Michigan.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **21,380** residents of Michigan.
