Economic Impact of Research²

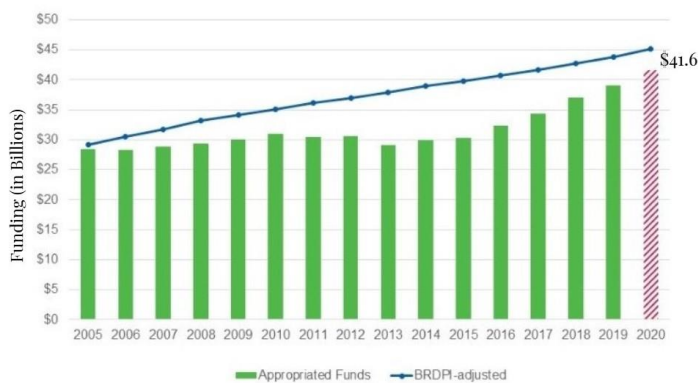
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$766.3 million** in Michigan, supporting **12,353 jobs** and **\$1.982 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Michigan supported **40,906 jobs** and **1,772 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Michigan³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **58,360** will reside in Michigan.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **21,150** residents of Michigan.
