### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

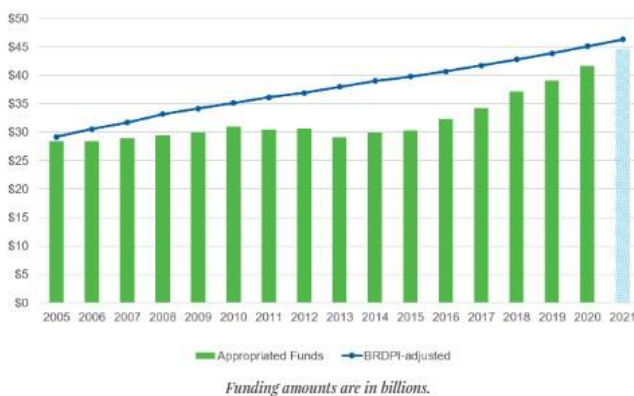
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$826.5 million** in Michigan, supporting **13,365** jobs and **\$2.144 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Michigan supported **40,206** jobs and **1,772** businesses.

#### Impact of Cancer in Michigan<sup>3</sup>

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **61,770** will reside in Michigan.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **21,000** residents of Michigan.
