### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

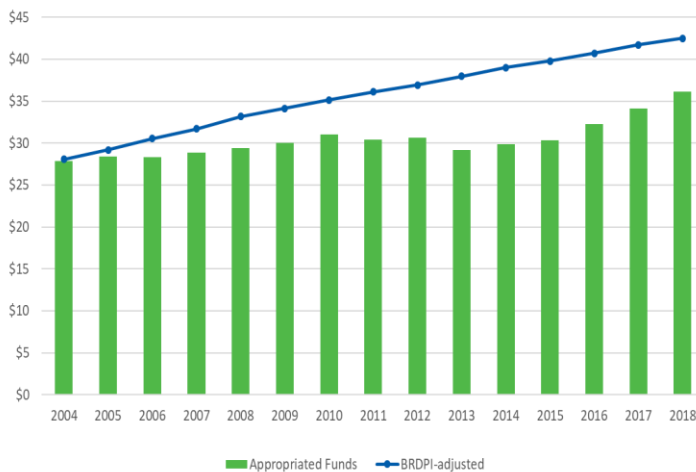
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$557.1 million** in Minnesota, supporting **8,398 jobs** and **\$1.453 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Minnesota supported **232,910 jobs** and **7,902 businesses**.

#### Impact of Cancer in Minnesota<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **31,270** will reside in Minnesota.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,080** residents of Minnesota.
