### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

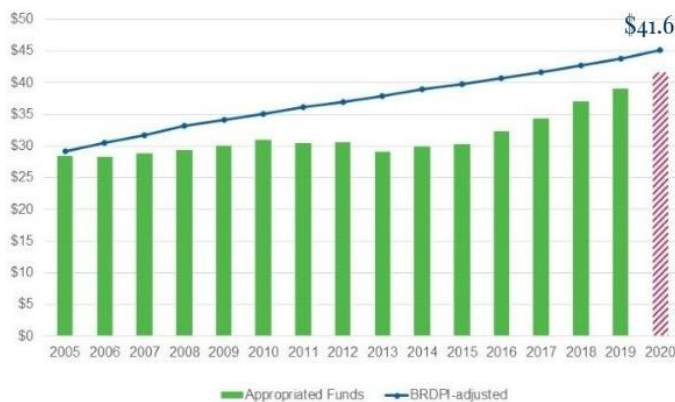
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$605.5 million** in Missouri, supporting **8,434** jobs and **\$1.455 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Missouri supported **29,047** jobs and **1,382** businesses.

#### Impact of Cancer in Missouri<sup>3</sup>

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **35,480** will reside in Missouri.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **13,080** residents of Missouri.

#### Siteman Cancer Center

**Siteman Cancer Center**, ranked among the top cancer treatment centers by U.S. News & World Report, also is one of only a few to receive the National Cancer Institute’s highest rating – “exceptional.” Comprising the cancer research, prevention and treatment programs of Barnes-Jewish Hospital and Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis, Siteman treats 50,000 people every year, including nearly 10,000 newly diagnosed cancer patients, also making it one of the nation’s largest cancer centers.
