Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$127.5 million** in Nebraska, supporting **2,238 jobs** and **\$317 million** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Nebraska supported **16,870 jobs** and **1,164 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Nebraska³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **10,560** will reside in Nebraska.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **3,520** residents of Nebraska.
