Economic Impact of Research²

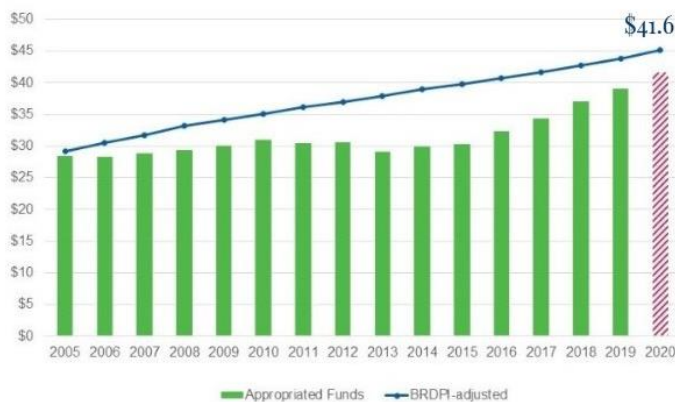
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$261.3 million** in New Jersey, supporting **5,187** jobs and **\$974 million** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in New Jersey supported **93,824** jobs and **2,897** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in New Jersey³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **53,400** will reside in New Jersey.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **15,860** residents of New Jersey.
