### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

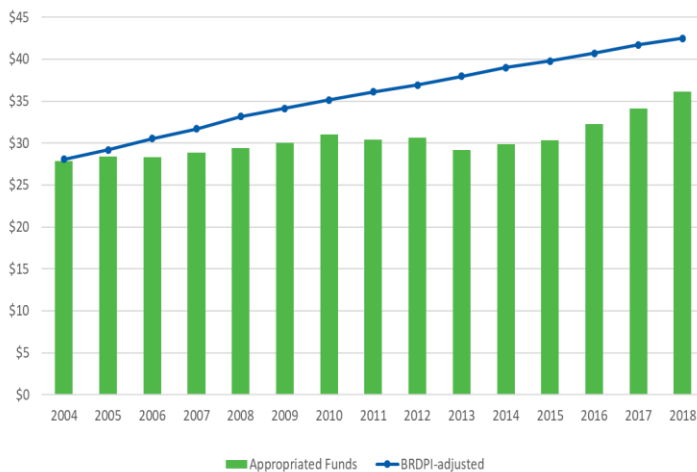
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$754.3 million** in Ohio, supporting **12,530** jobs and **\$2.047 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Ohio supported **45,090** jobs and **2,528** businesses.

#### Impact of Cancer in Ohio<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **68,470** will reside in Ohio.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **25,740** residents of Ohio.
