Economic Impact of Research²

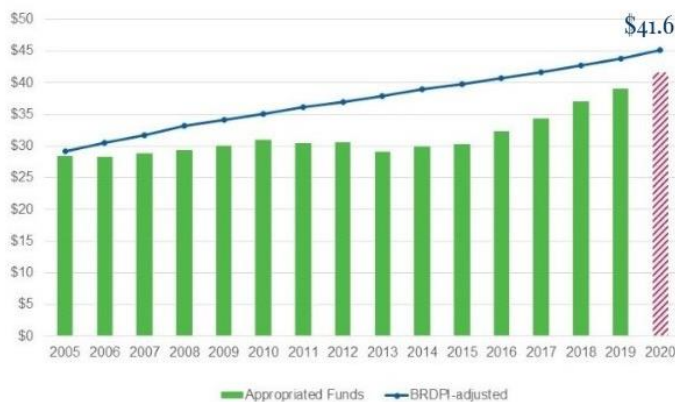
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$96.1 million** in Oklahoma, supporting **2,245** jobs and **\$309 million** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Oklahoma supported **9,698** jobs and **894** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Oklahoma³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **20,540** will reside in Oklahoma.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **8,420** residents of Oklahoma.
