Economic Impact of Research²

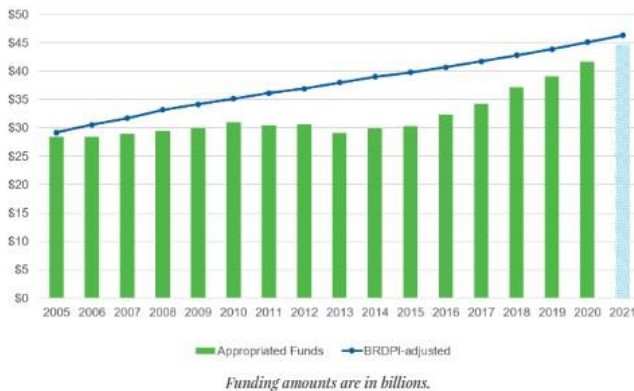
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$118.6 million** in Oklahoma, supporting **2,656** jobs and **\$366 million** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Oklahoma supported **9,698** jobs and **894** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Oklahoma³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **20,530** will reside in Oklahoma.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **8,430** residents of Oklahoma.
