Economic Impact of Research²

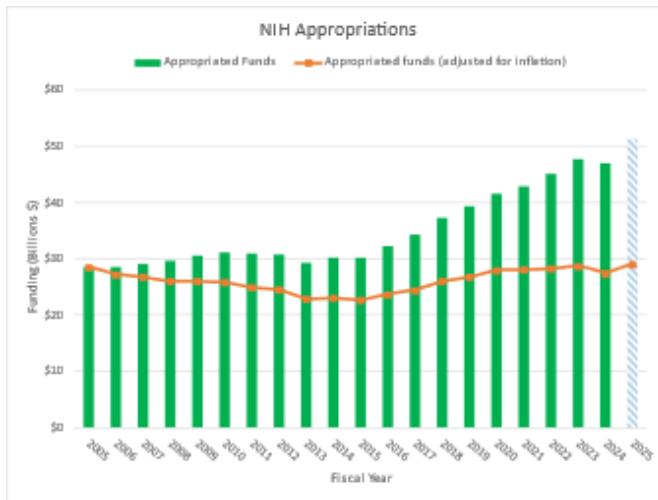
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2023, NIH funded awards totaling **\$148 million** in Oklahoma, supporting **2,490** jobs and **\$426 million** in economic activity.
- In FY 2023, the biopharmaceutical industry in Oklahoma supported **9,397** jobs and **1,264** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Oklahoma³

- In 2024, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **24,450** will reside in Oklahoma.
- In 2024, an estimated 611,720 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **8,650** residents of Oklahoma.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.22 billion for the NIH in FY 2025.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
