Economic Impact of Research²

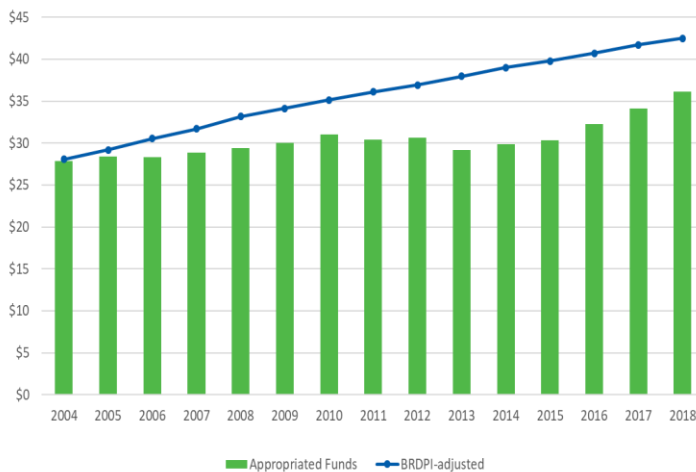
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$312.2 million** in Oregon, supporting **5,213 jobs** and **\$767.4 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Oregon supported **13,089 jobs** and **766 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Oregon³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **21,520** will reside in Oregon.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **8,310** residents of Oregon.
