Economic Impact of Research²

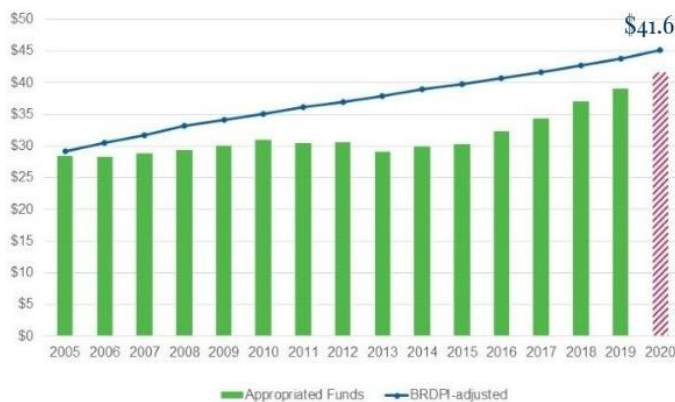
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$345.9 million** in Oregon, supporting **5,695** jobs and **\$838 million** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Oregon supported **13,400** jobs and **938** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Oregon³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **23,320** will reside in Oregon.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **8,270** residents of Oregon.
