### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

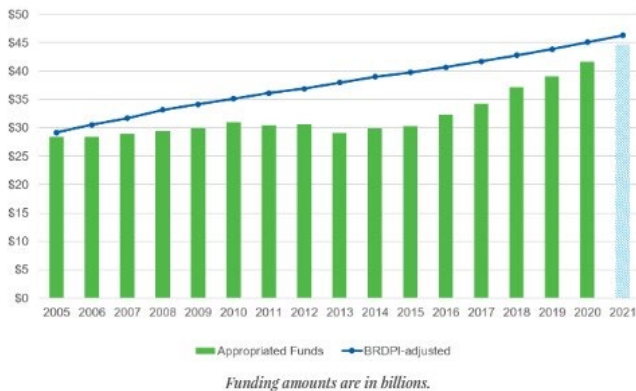
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$399.4 million** in Oregon, supporting **6,522 jobs** and **\$960 million** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Oregon supported **13,400 jobs** and **938 businesses**.

#### Impact of Cancer in Oregon<sup>3</sup>

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **23,330** will reside in Oregon.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **8,280** residents of Oregon.
