Economic Impact of Research²

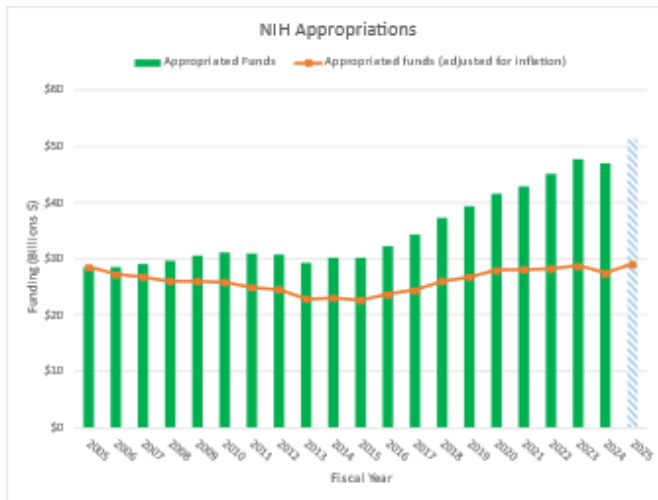
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2023, NIH funded awards totaling **\$417 million** in Oregon, supporting **5,013 jobs** and **\$992 million** in economic activity.
- In FY 2023, the biopharmaceutical industry in Oregon supported **16,812 jobs** and **1,628 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Oregon³

- In 2024, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **26,200** will reside in Oregon.
- In 2024, an estimated 611,720 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **8,670** residents of Oregon.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.22 billion for the NIH in FY 2025.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
