Economic Impact of Research²

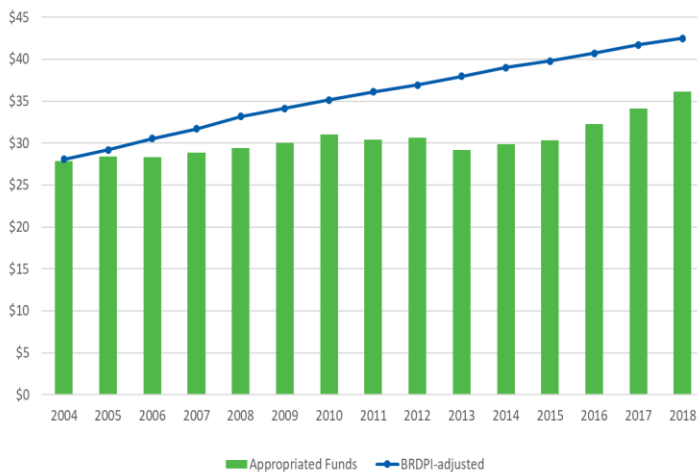
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.672 billion** in Pennsylvania, supporting **23,182 jobs** and **\$4.235 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Pennsylvania supported **77,547 jobs** and **2,272 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Pennsylvania³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **80,960** will reside in Pennsylvania.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **28,620** residents of Pennsylvania.
