Economic Impact of Research²

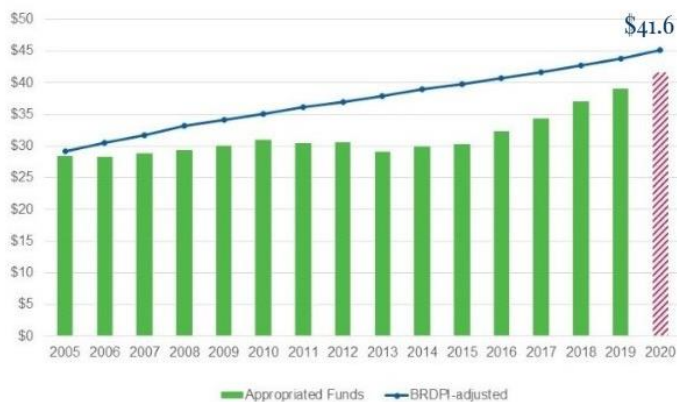
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.81 billion** in Pennsylvania, supporting **25,065 jobs** and **\$4.58 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Pennsylvania supported **81,036 jobs** and **2,517 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Pennsylvania³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **79,890** will reside in Pennsylvania.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **28,170** residents of Pennsylvania.
