Economic Impact of Research²

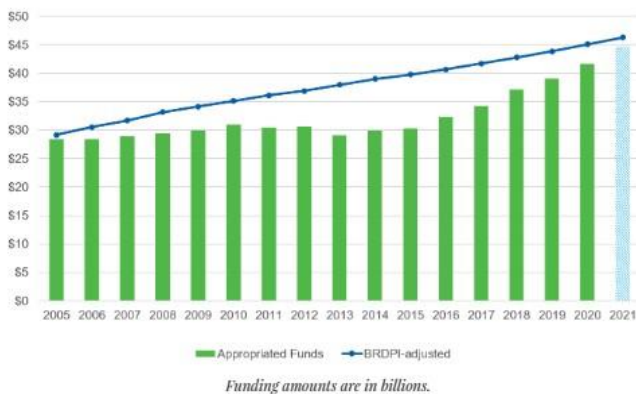
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.944 billion** in Pennsylvania, supporting **26,981** jobs and **\$4.930 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Pennsylvania supported **81,036** jobs and **2,517** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Pennsylvania³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **80,240** will reside in Pennsylvania.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **27,860** residents of Pennsylvania.
