United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$197 million** in South Carolina, supporting **3,959** jobs and **\$547 million** in economic activity.

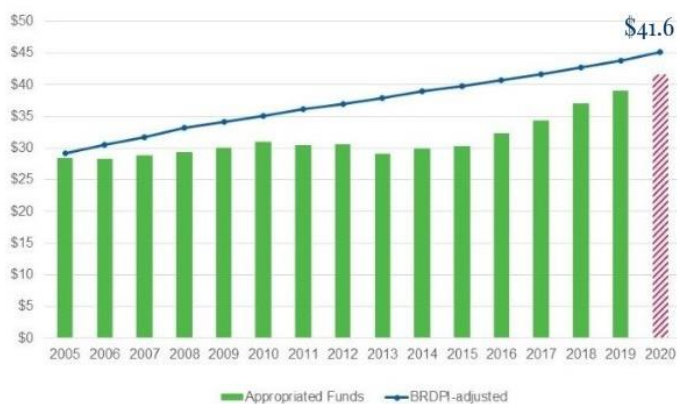
In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in South Carolina supported **13,967** jobs and **1,520** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in South Carolina³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **29,830** will reside in South Carolina.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,720** residents of South Carolina.
