Economic Impact of Research²

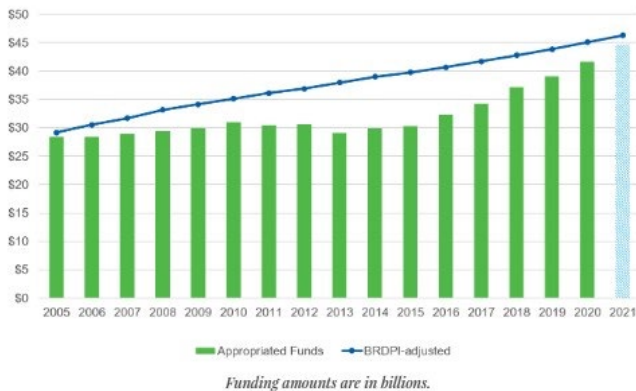
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$207 million** in South Carolina, supporting **4,208 jobs** and **\$582 million** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in South Carolina supported **13,967 jobs** and **1,520 businesses**

Impact of Cancer in South Carolina³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **31,710** will reside in South Carolina.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,780** residents of South Carolina.
