Economic Impact of Research²

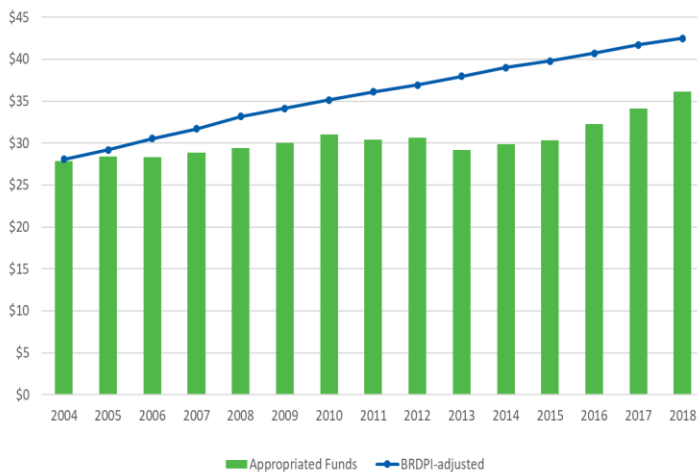
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$511.4 million** in Tennessee, supporting **8,027 jobs** and **\$1.32 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Tennessee supported **34,806 jobs** and **1,236 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Tennessee³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **36,760** will reside in Tennessee.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **14,900** residents of Tennessee.
