Economic Impact of Research²

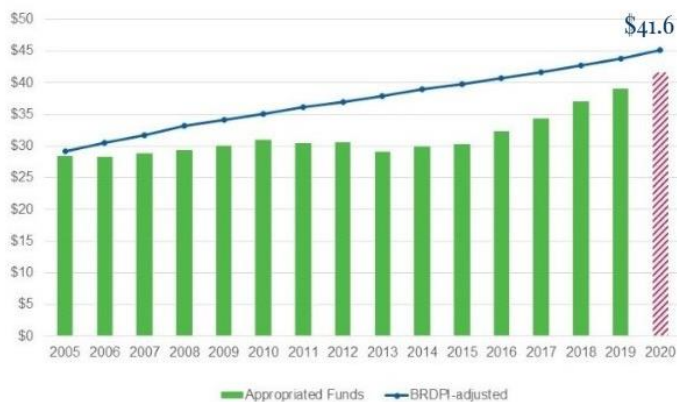
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.243 billion** in Texas, supporting **26,102 jobs** and **\$4.097 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Texas supported **89,746 jobs** and **5,578 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Texas³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **124,890** will reside in Texas.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **41,300** residents of Texas.
