Economic Impact of Research²

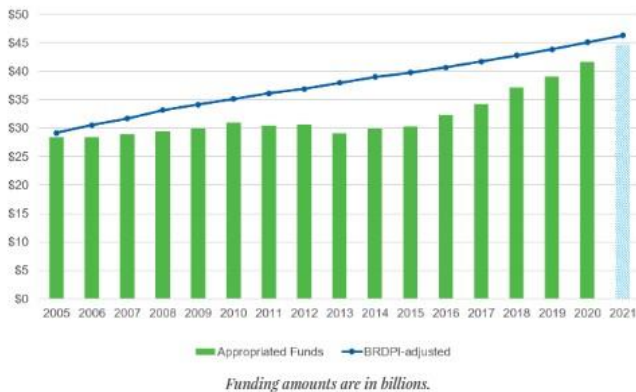
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.370 billion** in Texas, supporting **28,744** jobs and **\$4.512 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Texas supported **89,746** jobs and **5,578** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Texas³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **129,770** will reside in Texas.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **41,810** residents of Texas.
