Economic Impact of Research²

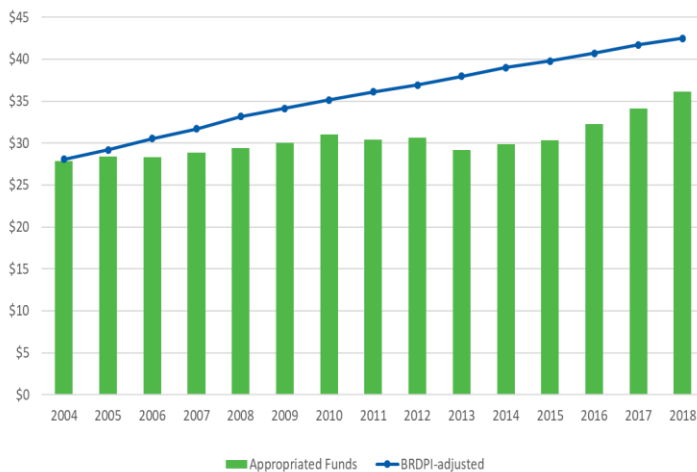
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$49.3 million** in Vermont, supporting **764 jobs** and **\$108.6 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Vermont supported **2,552 jobs** and **229 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Vermont³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **3,840** will reside in Vermont.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **1,450** residents of Vermont.
