Economic Impact of Research²

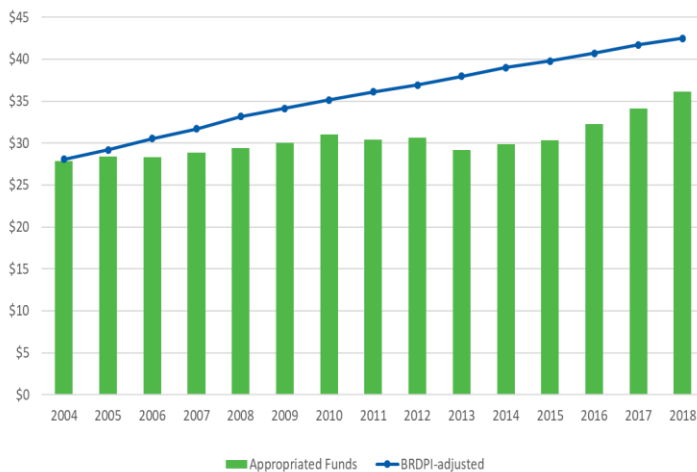
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$998.2 million** in Washington, supporting **14,051 jobs** and **\$2.425 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Washington supported **29,281 jobs** and **1,303 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Washington³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **36,170** will reside in Washington.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **13,030** residents of Washington.
