Economic Impact of Research²

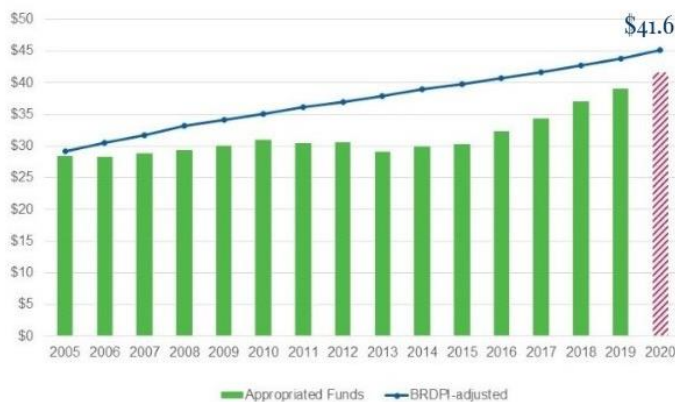
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.042 billion** in Washington, supporting **14,846** jobs and **\$2.562 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Washington supported **33,564** jobs and **1,744** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Washington³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **39,160** will reside in Washington.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **13,010** residents of Washington.

Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center

Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center is an independent, nonprofit research institute based in Seattle. Home to three Nobel laureates, its interdisciplinary teams of world-renowned scientists seek innovative ways to prevent, diagnose and treat cancer, HIV/AIDS, and other life-threatening diseases. Fred Hutch pioneered bone marrow transplantation and continues to advance today’s newest immunotherapies. The Hutch also houses the first NCI-funded cancer prevention program, the Women’s Health Initiative Clinical Coordinating Center and the HIV Vaccine Trials Network.
