Economic Impact of Research²

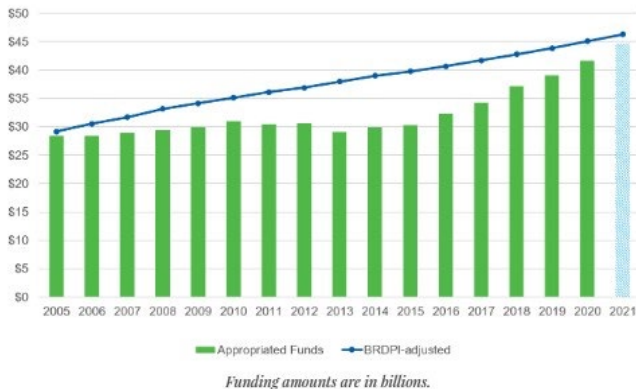
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.135 billion** in Washington, supporting **16,190 jobs** and **\$2.794 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Washington supported **33,564 jobs** and **1,744 businesses**

Impact of Cancer in Washington³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **36,290** will reside in Washington.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **13,020** residents of Washington.

Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center is an independent, nonprofit research institute based in Seattle. Home to three Nobel laureates, its interdisciplinary teams of world-renowned scientists seek innovative ways to prevent, diagnose, and treat cancer, HIV/AIDS, and other life-threatening diseases. Fred Hutch pioneered bone marrow transplantation and continues to advance today's newest immunotherapies. The Hutch also houses the first NCI-funded cancer prevention program, the Women's Health Initiative Clinical Coordinating Center and the HIV Vaccine Trials Network.
