Economic Impact of Research²

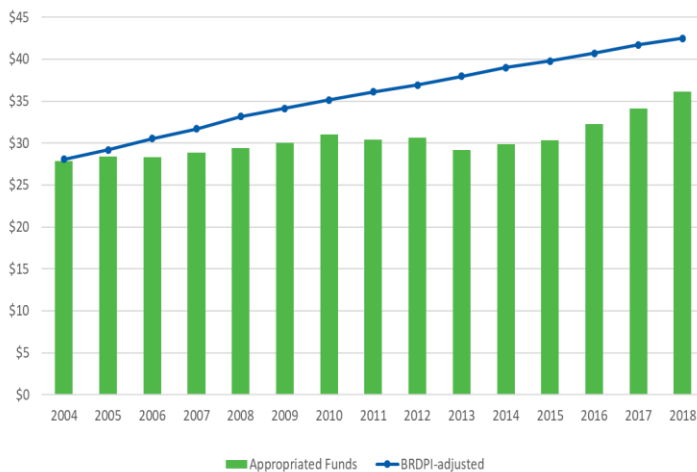
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$424.9 million** in Wisconsin, supporting **6,903 jobs** and **\$1.011 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Wisconsin supported **30,442 jobs** and **1,345 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Wisconsin³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **33,340** will reside in Wisconsin.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **11,840** residents of Wisconsin.
